Paul has undertaken significant work on applying materiality to sustainability strategy and risk management, as well assustainable supply chain management, supplier codes of conduct, and implementing supplier audit programs.

Paul was General Manager, Market Capability at the Infrastructure Sustainability Council (ISC), the peak body in Australia and NZ for enabling sustainability outcomes in the planning, design, construction and operation of infrastructure. Paul has developed and delivered training for over 400 practitioners in IS ratings, sustainability management, sustainable procurement, and culture change. Paul also led key collaborative projects for ISC around pathways for infrastructure achieving net zero emissions, identifying social and economic returns of sustainability ratings, and managing modern slavery risk in infrastructure supply chains. Paul is also currently a trainer and verifier for ISCA.

From 2015 to 2018, Paul led the sustainability team on the Sydney Metro Northwest Operations, Trains and Stations Phase for three years to help deliver all 500+ sustainability-related aspects of the project. This included climate risk evaluations and adaptions, life cycle analysis, energy consumption modelling, supply chain assessments, sustainable workforce initiatives and community outcomes. Paul was also part of NRT's Executive Team on the SPV (OpCo) responsible for managing communications and sustainabilityfor Northwest Rapid Transit Pty Ltd.

From 2007 to 2015, Paul was Principal Consultant at Banarra (now KPMG-Banarra), a consultancy specializing in social and human rights, sustainable procurement, sustainability strategy, GRI reporting and AA1000 assurance.
